Rowena Cade created the Minack as a community asset to bring people together for entertainment and creative endeavour. As part of her legacy, we seek to engage as many people as possible in creating theatre through an extensive engagement programme.

We work closely with schools, community groups and individuals to provide arts activities, especially for young people and the socially disadvantaged. This work is funded entirely by income generated from the Minack Theatre as a tourist attraction and performance venue.

It is a great privilege to be a part of a project like Bal Govenek, that involves so many young people working together to create wonderful performances on our stage. I have been lucky enough to be involved in the arts all of my life and the experiences I had as a young person have really shaped the way I grew up and informed the choices I have made in life.

In recent years the arts offering in our schools has been severely reduced and opportunities for young people to explore the world and develop through a cultural and artistic journey are not always available.

Arts Council England is very clear about the intrinsic value of cultural experiences as well as pointing out that ‘there is strong evidence that participation in the arts can contribute to community cohesion, reduce social exclusion and isolation, and/or make communities feel safer and stronger’.

This combined with the fact that the cultural industries contribute over ten billion pounds per year to the UK economy means that it is essential that these experiences are for everyone and not just a privileged few.

Since 2016 the Minack has developed a raft of learning and participation opportunities reaching out to schools and the whole of our community. This is funded entirely by the income we receive from people visiting our beautiful theatre and we are delighted to join again with Cornwall Music Service Trust to bring you Bal Govenek this year.
